

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR DEL LEBEL

While the new year is a time to set ambitions for bold change, it is also an opportunity to reflect on what was accomplished in the year prior. In this spirit, I am proud to share the Alexion Political Action Committee (PAC) second annual report showcasing the PAC's major milestones from 2022.

Over the past year, AlexionPAC has shown significant positive growth, exemplified by a membership base that is now comprised of nearly 100 Alexion colleagues who collectively contributed more than \$63,000 to amplify the voice of rare disease policymaking. These contributions, in combination with funding from prior years, allowed our PAC to support over 50 federal candidates who share a passion for health policy, interest in the rare disease community, and understanding of the value of biotechnology



innovation. Our efforts in 2022 have also served to benefit the communities where we live and work, as demonstrated by AlexionPAC's first annual Charitable PAC Match Campaign yielding over \$30,000 in charitable donations to more than 50 organizations.

Forging progress for rare diseases patients is at the center of what we do. Our PAC allows Alexion to strengthen connections with rare disease policy champions and to have a voice in the discussions happening on Capitol Hill that directly affect access to timely diagnosis, care, and treatment for rare disease patients. In the year ahead, there will be opportunities to ensure the voice of rare disease is represented as new drug pricing regulations are implemented and access policies are considered. Advocacy will be a critical component to any effort we embark upon so we must ensure Alexion is in a strong position to deploy all our advocacy tools, including the AlexionPAC.

On behalf of the AlexionPAC Board of Directors, I offer a sincere thank you for all those who have supported our efforts in effectuating positive change for rare disease patients and their families. For those who are looking to take part – there is no better time to join us. Cheers to a successful 2022, and to a 2023 marked with great progress.

2022 CAMPAIGNS

As we seek to expand awareness, participation, and employee engagement in the PAC, AlexionPAC launched two bold campaigns in 2022.

The AlexionPAC Charitable Match Program is a new benefit that allows colleagues to both support Alexion PAC and their favorite charity at the same time. The program, which launched last spring, was a booming success, with 31 donors joining or increasing their AlexionPAC contribution, 59 unique charities supported, and over \$31,000 being donated to external charities, aligning with our missionto support communities where we live and work.

As a way to support our membership base while also furthering our mission, Alexion PAC launched a sweepstakes program to garner new members and to provide two colleagues with an Airbnb giftcard to spend on a trip of their choice! Here's what one of the winners have to say:

CANDIDATE CONTRIBUTIONS

AlexionPAC is non-partisan and decisions to support candidates are made independent of party affiliation.

In 2022, AlexionPAC contributed to a record number of candidates who align with our company's values and objectives through demonstrated support for spurring innovation, prioritizing science, and developing patient centric solutions for rare disease populations. In the 2022 election, we supported 53 candidates in a nearly 50/50 split between Republican and Democrat candidate contributions.

The result? Resounding success. 100% of the legislators who received AlexionPAC support won their general election race.

The contributions from 117 AlexionPAC members, in combination with prior funds, allowed us to disburse \$115,000 to rare disease policy champions in 2022. To check out the full list of candidates that received contributions, check out AlexionPAC.com.
